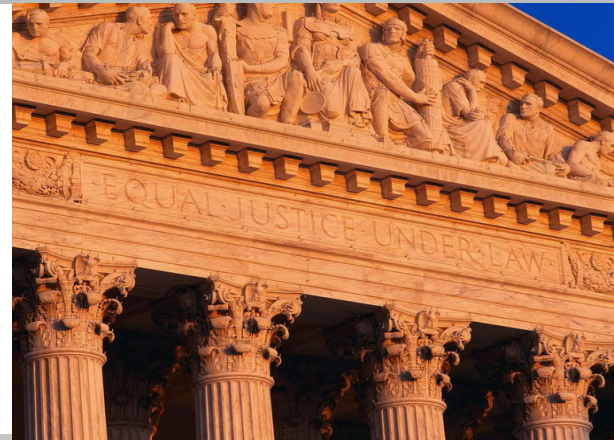


● IMMIGRATION AND AGEING IN EUROPE (EURIE)
